The courses that are provided on the course are designed to help you achieve the next level in your Stage Combat training. Should you have **NO** experience or they have taken less than three A.P.C syllabus courses or a Basic exam with another organisation (proof required), you will begin with the **BASIC course**. If you have completed the Basic exam or a Basic, the next course for is the **Intermediate**. Advanced can only be taken if you have taken and passed the **Intermediate** course. Regardless of personal experience these exam must be taken in this order. The one Weapon Honours is designed for people who have their advanced qualification.

Please note: Taking the course does **not** give you an automatic qualification regarding the Basic, Intermediate, Advanced and Honours courses

Please note that the weapons listed below are subject to change and if are signing up for this course, you will be informed of any changes made:

Basic: Single sword, Rapier + Dagger, Unarmed

Intermediate: Staff, Knife, Rapier and Gauntlet

Honours: 1st Honours course: Sai Vs Sword / 2nd Honours course: Found weapons

Advanced: Unarmed (swimming pool), case of rapiers, Sabre, unarmed (special) Gadius and shield
